FIREARMS SAFETY RULES AGREEMENT**

A. CARDINAL RULES OF FIREARMS SAFETY:

1. Treat all firearms as though they were loaded.
2. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until you are on target and decided to fire.
3. Point the muzzle in a safe direction at all times.
4. Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
5. The designated range master/instructor has the final word.

REMEMBER THE "LASER RULE":

**TREAT YOUR FIREARM AS IF IT IS A LASER GUN WITH THE BEAM ALWAYS ON:
WHATEVER THE LASER BEAM TOUCHES, IT CUTS THROUGH!**

B. SPECIFIC RULES:

1. No Semi-automatic firearms
2. Do you have any physical disability, limitation, illness or other condition that would affect your ability to participate safely in any aspect of this program? ____ Yes ____ No
3. Are you under the influence of any prescription/non prescription drug or alcohol that would influence your safe participation in any aspect of this program? ____ Yes ____ No
4. Ear and eye protection are required to be worn **at all times** while firing is being conducted on the range.
5. Immediately upon picking up a firearm, keep your finger off the trigger, point the muzzle in a safe direction, open the action and check both visually and physically to see that it is unloaded.
6. **Check condition a second time.**
7. Never give a firearm to, or take a firearm from anyone, unless the action is open for inspection.
8. Load/reload/unload only after position is taken at the firing point and on command.
9. **NEVER** handle, load or unload firearms behind other shooters.
10. Keep the firearm pointed down range at all times.
11. **NEVER** holster a cocked weapon (cocked and locked weapons excluded).
12. Never go forward of the firing line unless instructed.
13. Never step back from the firing line unless your handgun is safely holstered or placed on the firing table.
14. **Never** bend over to retrieve dropped articles while the firing line is hot.
15. Pay strict attention to the range master/instructor.
16. Never anticipate a command.
17. Never permit the muzzle of a firearm to touch the ground.
18. Conduct a proper safety check of the weapon before and after a firing session.
19. All safety precautions must be adhered to and will be enforced.
20. You are expected to use good judgment, and to refrain from attempting any exercise which you may not be able to perform safely based upon your own ability, equipment, prior training or physical condition,
21. **REMEMBER - Everyone has the responsibility for range safety.**
22. **Shooting on the range is a privilege** - Anyone not obeying rules at all times may be asked to safely leave the range.
23. Always wash hands and face after leaving the range and shower & change clothing at the end of a shooting day to reduce the possibility of lead contamination.
24. When firearms are not in use at the range, they are to be double-locked (locked trigger/case and locked in trunk of a vehicle).
